ABIC 04 - Arabic Language in Jordan (Monthly Program)

Ali Baba International Center (ABIC) is an Arabic Language Institute situated in the heart of Amman, the vibrant capital of Jordan. The Center offers year-round instruction through twelve monthly programs, available continuously throughout the year. A typical monthly program includes three core components: (1) an intensive Arabic language course, (2) comfortable, student-friendly accommodation, and (3) a dynamic schedule of extracurricular activities and guided tours to Jordan's most renowned historical and cultural sites. Course Academics

At the heart of a monthly program is the Arabic language course. Key details—such as instructional hours, proficiency levels, core textbooks, thematic content, credit transfer guidelines, and program dates—are outlined below.

- Number of Hours: Each week includes 20 hours of instruction, with classes held five days a week for four hours per day. This schedule results in approximately 80 instructional hours per month.
- Levels: Each group course is offered at three main levels: beginner, intermediate, and advanced. Depending on enrollment, these levels may be further divided into sub-levels to better accommodate students' needs. Placement into small, level-appropriate groups is determined by the results of an online placement test and a pre-course interview.
- **Text Books**: The instructional materials at ABIC are primarily drawn from two internationally recognized textbooks—Al-Kitaab and Al-Asas—and are further enriched with a range of supplementary resources and interactive activities.
- Topics and Content: The course emphasizes all key language skills, including listening, speaking, pronunciation, reading, writing, vocabulary, grammar, and interactive activities. Course content is tailored by the instructor to match the students' proficiency level and specific language needs. At the intermediate and advanced levels, instruction covers a broad range of topics, including Arabic media, politics, and contemporary issues in the Arab world, among others.
- Official Credit Transfer and Equivalency: ABIC issues official transcripts upon completion of each monthly program and can provide additional documentation to help home institutions facilitate direct credit transfer. Typically, one academic credit hour corresponds to every 15 to 20 contact hours completed at ABIC.
- Course Dates: The twelve programs scheduled for the 2025 calendar year are offered on the following dates:

- o July 6/7 Aug 3/8 Sep 31/8 Oct 28/9 Nov 26/10 Dec 23/11

Accommodation Options

ABIC offers a range of housing options to suit different preferences, including private apartments, shared apartments, and homestays with local Jordanian families. • Private Studio:

A compact, open-plan living space that includes a bedroom, private bathroom, and kitchenette.

• Private Apartment:


A fully furnished unit featuring a separate bedroom, bathroom, kitchenette, and living area.

• Shared Apartment:

A multi-bedroom unit shared with other students, offering shared access to a bathroom, kitchenette, and living area.

• Homestay with a Local Family:

Includes a private bedroom and bathroom, along with two home-cooked meals per day, providing a culturally immersive experience.




Cultural Engagement: On-Campus Events and Off-Campus Trips

Each week, ABIC organizes a variety of engaging extracurricular activities, both on-campus and off-campus, designed to enhance students' cultural immersion and language learning experience. These activities range from interactive workshops and cultural events to guided excursions across Jordan. A sample of these activities is listed below. - On-Campus Activities: A variety of cultural experiences are offered on-site, including Arabic calligraphy workshops, henna design sessions, colored sand bottle art, traditional Jordanian lunch days, and cultural open house events. These activities provide hands-on engagement with Arab traditions and customs.
- Off-Campus Trips: The program includes three organized day trips every month:
 - o A guided tour of downtown Amman with a traditional Jordanian breakfast (Week 1)
 - o An unforgettable visit to the ancient city of Petra (Week 2)
 - o A combined trip to Jerash and Ajloun, exploring Roman ruins and scenic hilltop castles (Week 3).
- Language Partner Program: Students are paired with local university students to practice conversational Arabic and build meaningful cross-cultural connections through informal language exchange.

Program Cost

Program costs vary depending on the selected accommodation option. Below is a detailed breakdown:



- Course Tuition Fees:
 - o \$1,100 for -1 month programs
 - o \$1,900 for -2month programs
 - o \$2,700 for -3month programs
- Accommodation Fees (per month):
 - o \$Homestay with a local family: \$850
 - o Private studio apartment: \$650
 - o Shared standard apartment: \$550

• Off-Campus Excursions: Included, with the exception of entrance fees to historical and cultural sites

Scholarships and Financial Support

Students are encouraged to apply for external funding opportunities such as the Boren Awards, Fulbright Program, Fund for Education Abroad, Benjamin A. Gilman International Scholarship, FLAS, and others. ABIC also offers partial financial aid to eligible students.

Registration and Admission

Registration Deadline

There is no fixed registration deadline for monthly programs. Enrollment is accepted on a rolling basis, and seats are allocated in the order applications are received until the course reaches full capacity. Early registration is recommended to secure a place.
